



General Benefits







- ✓ Mutual Recognition Agreement Benefits (MRA)
- ✓ Active participation in updating laws and customs procedures related to AEO (Consultive Group)
- ✓ Requirement waiver when asking for special customs regimes
- ✓ RFB and AEO certified members joint workshops and trainings



Benefits to AEO-S



- ✓ Lower rate of document and physical controls in EXPORT operations
- ✓ Real time channel definition
- ✓ Priority on document and physical controls
- ✓ Guarantee waiver for transit



Benefits to AEO-C Tier 1



- ✓ Priority on AEO Classification of Goods Decision (maximum of 40 days)
- ✓ Guarantee waiver for temporary admission

Benefits to AEO-C Tier 2



- ✓ Permission to submit import declaration before the goods arrival
- ✓ Green channel for Temporary Admission (document and physical controls waiver)

Admissibility Requirements

Eletronic Application

Tax ID Number and Tax collection for at least 24 months

Eletronic Tax Domicile

Minimum of 24 months operation

Digital Bookkeeping

Specific Authorization , if necessary

Tax Compliance

Minimum of 3 years of experience and exam approval (only for customs brokers)

No AEO certification denial in the last 6 months






